Do not drive yourself or the person having the stroke to the hospital. Instead, **call 911** so paramedics can quickly take you to the best hospital for stroke care.

FACE is it drooping?

A RMS can you raise both?

S PEECH is it slurred or jumbled?

T I ME to call 9-1-1 right away.

ACT **F A S T** BECAUSE THE QUICKER YOU ACT,
THE MORE OF THE PERSON YOU SAVE.
